Richard L. Pullano is the founder of Pullano Law Offices in Chicago, Illinois. His career began when he served as Prosecutor for the Cook County State's Attorney's Office, where he prosecuted felony cases for the Gang Crimes Unit. He has worked exclusively in the field of personal injury law since 1987. During this time, he has handled every type of injury case, including transportation liability, medical negligence, product liability, premises liability, aviation liability, construction negligence, and general negligence.

Mr. Pullano has extensive litigation experience in jury trials, and he has obtained numerous multi-million-dollar verdicts and settlements for his clients. These include a record-breaking \$14 million settlement for a victim of a tow truck accident, a record-breaking \$2.5 million verdict for the wrongful death of a 90-year-old man who was struck by a vehicle, a \$4.5 million jury verdict in a medical malpractice case involving failure to diagnose lung cancer, and a \$3.7 million award for a pipe fitter who was burned with sulfuric acid while on the job.

In addition, Richard has achieved success in cases involving aviation accidents. He represented the pilots of Turkish Airlines flight 1951, which crashed in Amsterdam in 2009. He also obtained a multi-million-dollar settlement in New York Federal Court for a wrongful death which occurred in a helicopter crash.

Mr. Pullano received his law degree from DePaul University (J.D., 1982) and earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Notre Dame (B.A., 1979). He has been named as one of America's Top 100 Attorneys, he has been recognized as an Illinois Super Lawyer since 2006, and he has been named an Illinois Leading Lawyer by the Chicago Daily Law Bulletin.
